Volunteer Opportunities at Dow Rummel Village

1. Reading to the residents in the Eva Allen Health Care Center, the Assisted Living Center or the Memory Care Center, especially individuals struggling with visual impairments. Reading may include the daily and weekly newspapers, magazines and books.
2. Share the outdoors on the grounds of Dow Rummel, Terrace Park (1 block away) or Veteran's Park (1 ½ block) away by either walking with resident and / or assisting with walkers and wheelchairs.
3. Saturday Swimming Pool Volunteering - Pool hours are 8:30 am - 10:30 am; Training will be provided. Duties will consist primarily of opening and closing the pool area as well as being present during the hours of operation.
4. Assisting with a water / land exercise class.
5. Organizing and / or conducting a Travel Club - presentation or garden club
6. Playing board games, card games, bingo and or craft activities with the residents in the Eva Allen Health Care Center, the Assisted Living Center or the Memory Care Center.
7. Playing Shuffleboard and or Bean Bag Toss or Ladder Ball with residents in the Assisted Living Center.
8. Planting flowers and gardening with the residents in the Assisted Living Center or Memory Care Center.
9. Resident Outing Aide - assisting staff in providing off-campus resident opportunities.
10. Pet visits - share your approved pet with the residents.
11. Provide musical entertainment for the residents in the Eva Allen Health Care Center, the Assisted Living Center or the Memory Care Center- playing the piano, hosting sing-alongs, playing other musical instruments.
12. "Pony Express" Aide - assist residents with receiving and / or responding to emails from their family & friends, sending birthday and holiday greetings.
13. "Nail care" Aide - pampering residents with weekly nail care sessions which include filing and polishing nails for the residents in the Eva Allen Health Care Center, the Assisted Living Center or the Memory Care Center.

14. "Resident Chauffer" - assist residents in attending programs offered in the Halladay-Peterson Chapel, especially for residents living in Village North who need a wheelchair or a walker, attending programs in the Chapel may not be worth the effort; a "resident chauffer" would meet at their apartment to assist to the program and after to assist in returning to their apartment.
15. Entertainment & Program Greeter - greeting & ushering guests attending programs most frequently offered in the Halladay-Peterson Chapel.
16. Accompanying & assisting the "Dow Rummel Village People" when performing at the Fighting Pheasants Baseball games.
17. Volunteer Bus driver for special events - providing transportation to Fighting Pheasant Baseball Games, Christmas Lights Tours, special concerts & events in the Sioux Falls area. Specific qualifications do apply.
18. Newsletter contributor - writing news articles for the monthly News & Notes Newsletter featuring a resident, an employee or specific news/health issue.
19. Holiday Decorating - especially prior to the Christmas Holiday - decorating one or several of the many Christmas trees that are displayed at Dow Rummel Village during the month of December also in putting decorations away after the Holiday Season.
20. Assisting with the annual Casino Night, Spring Classic Car Show and Drive-Inn, Summer Carnival, Sioux Falls Municipal Band Concerts, quarterly Ice Cream Socials.
21. Volunteer Instructors - share a special skill or talent - teach a computer class, offer a craft class, provide a cooking class. Do you have an idea of something you would like to share - the opportunities are endless.
22. Movie Attendant - assist with monthly movie showings on the 1st Tuesday evening (6:30 pm) of each month and the third Friday afternoon (1:30 pm) of each month. Assist in transporting residents from various care areas to the Elmen Room prior to showings and returning after. Assist in distributing popcorn and soda prior to showing and in cleaning up after the movie. Typically will require 3 hours per show.
23. Office Assistant / Aide - assist as needed with filing, coping, mailings etc. Hours are flexible and varied based on duties to be completed. Training provided.
24. Dow Rummel Main Street Store Aide - assist residents with purchasing gift, food and toiletry items, must be able to collect money and make change, assist in stocking items on shelves, tracking and ordering inventory as needed. Training provided. Store hours are Monday - Friday, 9:45 am - 11:45 am and 1:00 pm - 3:30 pm and Saturdays, 9:45 am - 11:45 am.

25. Dow Rummel Village Library Aide - assist residents in checking out library books, assist in returning books into circulation by checking in and shelving as appropriate. Maintaining book cards as needed. Training provided, shifts are typically 2 hours; library hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 am - 6:00 pm.
26. Covell's Dining Room Assistant - assist with tracking meal plan or meal punch card activity in Covell's Dining Room, either for the noon lunch, or evening dinner hours are available Sunday - Saturday, typically 1 - 1 1/2 hours per meal.
